- No undergarments showing (i.e. tank tops and/or underwear)
- No clothing with explicit or inappropriate language of sexual, violent, and or drug nature

  may wear any religiously, ethnically, or culturally specific head coverings or hairstyles,
  including but not limited to hijabs, yarmulkes, and head/hair wraps.
